The Board of Directors would like to begin by wishing everyone a HAPPY NEW YEAR! The BOD has lined up some very exciting activities for the new year. We have four (4) workshops planned, two bus trips, our member show and reception, exhibition opportunities, implementation of the new plein air group and some unique demonstrations. There is a character artist presenting in March and Bob Merwin who is a very well known artist in the area will be providing a demonstration in May. In addition there will be a mosaic, pottery demonstration and an opportunity to participate in Rock and Roar at Ross Park. Also, the BOD is planning a special fundraising activity in the FALL. Information about each of the venues will be included in FASST newsletters, the website and in special e-mails so watch for details. If you have recommendations for other activities that may be of interest to FASST members, please do not hesitate to contact any Board member or me.

As reported last month, the MALL Gallery location is currently being used by a temporary store. I will be meeting with the new manager in the near future to discuss potential opportunities at the MALL for FASST. In the mean time, the BOD is continuing to identify other locations where our artists can exhibit and sell their pieces. Some are listed on the second page of this newsletter. The BOD will highlight new opportunities as they arise and report them in our various publications.

Since the MALL site was not available for the March 2017 Young at Art Show for high School students, the Board searched for another location that would allow for 20 schools and over 160 pieces to be exhibited. Unfortunately, the BOD was not successful in finding another location to support this show. Therefore, with regret the local schools were notified in December that the YAA show would not occur in 2017. The BOD, however, is planning to host the show in 2018 and will be working diligently to find a location.

Finally, the BOD is pleased to report that the end of year financial report showed another positive result and we would like to thank all members for their continued support of the Fine Arts Society of the Southern Tier, Inc.

About 14 years ago, I decided to explore art after putting it off due to work and family obligations. After I tried it, I was hooked. I took classes at Fine Design Art Studio in Maine, NY, and started doing oil paintings. At the same time, I kept learning through videos, books and attending workshops.

Then I starting doing acrylic painting with Robert Merwin, Artistic Visions Studio, Owego, NY, and I have been painting there with a group of artists for the past several years.



My favorite subjects are landscapes. Nature is so beautiful and no matter where you look, there is something that catches your eye. I take photographs when we travel, which is my inspiration for new paintings. My hope is for others to love nature as much as I do through my art.

I also paint black and white gesso pieces with oil glazes, usually of forest scenes showing sun shining through the branches, waterfalls, etc. I frame all of my paintings using ready-made frames.
